The Kentucky District Camp Ground was purchased in 1966 from the Nazarenes of Summersville for \$30,000.00. The original purchase consisted of approximately 10 acres, an old barn for services, an old block building that at one time had been a chicken hatchery, and some run down cabins. Improvements since that time have consisted of two new dorms, a new 15,000 sq. ft. tabernacle that will accommodate 1400 people, renovation of the cafeteria, including two new walk-in coolers, and new gas ranges, new shower facilities for both boys and girls, paving of interior roads, a new city sewer system, a new building for housing guest speakers and nurses station, as well as many small private cabins. All of our dormitories have centralized air conditioning and can be heated in the winter. We have upgraded our total electric system, making it capable of handling new accommodations as well.

Our goals are to create a facility that will accommodate people of all ages to come together for healthy Christian life enrichment, recreation, fellowship, good food prepared by capable people, and comfortable accommodations that are affordable to most everybody. We operate strictly non-profit, with our upkeep and improvements made possible through donations from our churches throughout the state. These donations have come from \$1-a-week programs that are strictly on a voluntary basis, pledges from United Pentecostal Churches, as well as many individuals. We operate on a shoe string budget with help donated from within our church organization.

OUR NEEDS ARE MANY

DORMITORIES

We need more and larger dormitories for our boys and our girls. We have to turn people away due to lack of housing space.

CAFETERIA

Our cafeteria is much too small to accommodate the people that we are now getting at our camps. People have to wait in long lines, sometimes in the rain, to be able to have a place to sit and eat.

SPACES FOR MORE CABINS

We have the land but we need many more hookups to accommodate the many RV's that are coming to our camps for their summer vacations and fellowship of the people.

NEW TABERNACLE

Our 15,000 sq. ft. tabernacle for our classes and evening worship has reached its maximum capacity.
